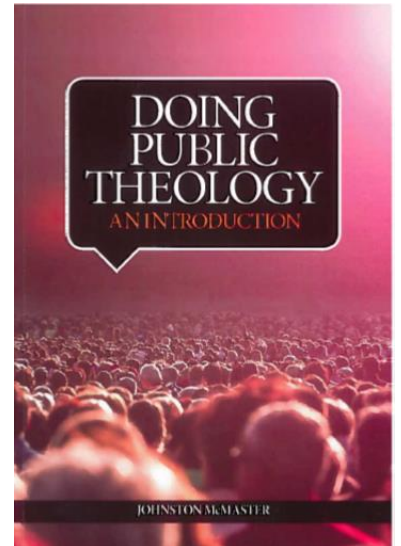


Doing G-O-D in Public - The Practice of Public Theology

Programme at Drumalis over 9 Sunday afternoons in 2018-2019

Following the six session introductory course on Public Theology, and in response to participants' feedback, a follow-up course is planned for 2018-2019.
