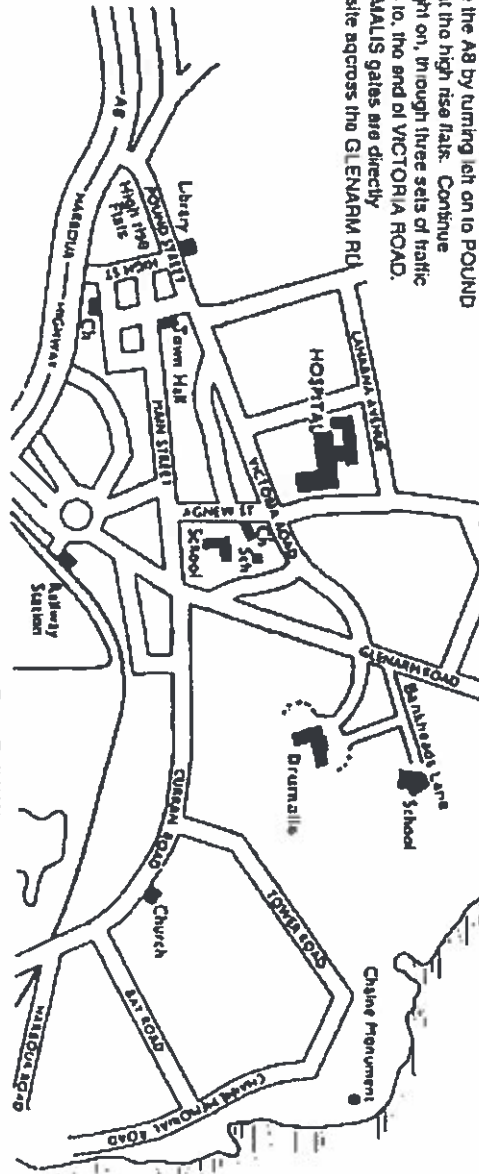

DIRECTIONS

From BELFAST take the M2 and leave it at the A8 exit. Just outside Larne leave the A8 by turning left on to POUND ST. at the high rise flats. Continue straight on, through three sets of traffic lights to the end of VICTORIA ROAD. DRUMALIS gates are directly opposite across the GLENARM RD



From RAILWAY, BUS and HARBOUR follow the signs for the 'Coast Road'. DRUMALIS is on the right before BANKHEADS LANE before you leave the town.

Magdalen Lawler SND is a Sister of Notre Dame, living in London. She has taught art and religious studies and worked in retreats, spiritual direction and student chaplaincy. She has a special interest in women's spirituality and in the relationship between spirituality and the visual arts. Her most recent publications are 'Christ, Our Morning Star', 'Love Bade me Welcome' and 'Show us the Father'.

Tom McGuinness SJ is a former Director of St Beuno's Spirituality Centre and of The Ignatian Spirituality Centre in Glasgow.
