


GETTING TO DRUMALIS



From BELFAST take the M2 and leave it at the A8 exit. Just outside LARNE leave the A8 by turning left onto POUND STREET at the high rise flats. Continue straight on, through three sets of traffic lights, to the end of VICTORIA ROAD. Drumalis gates are directly opposite, across the GLENARM ROAD.

From RAILWAY, BUS and HARBOUR, follow the signs for the "Coastal Route". Drumalis is on the right after you cross the traffic lights. It is situated just before the turn off for BANKHEADS LANE.





MOVIE NIGHTS AT DRUMALIS

Beginning in our Autumn term we are delighted to offer a Movie Night. These movie nights will be held on the first Thursday of each month and will run from October 2018 to April 2019.

Our presenter, Eileen O' Brien will offer a brief introduction to the movie being shown. After the movie there will be the opportunity to reflect both personally and as a group on the issues and values illustrated. The movies in this series come from France, Spain, USA and Britain. Through these movies we get a glimpse of what it means to be truly human; nobility of character shines through in them all.

Thurs, 4 Oct Sully (US, 2016, 96 mins, Cert PG-13)

This is a film about Captain Sullenberger's emergency landing of a US Airways Flight in January 2009 on the Hudson River. The film also explores the subsequent publicity and investigation.

Thurs, 1 Nov To Kill a Mocking Bird (UK, 1963, 129 mins)

Atticus Finch is a highly respected lawyer in a small Alabama town in the 1930's. He puts his career on the line when he agrees to represent Tom Robinson, a black man who is accused of assaulting a white woman.

Thurs, 6 Dec The Nativity (UK, 2011, 111 mins, Cert PG)

This is a compelling adaptation of one of the most famous stories in human history. It is the story of the birth of Jesus Christ.

Thurs, 3 Jan Life, Animated (US, 2016, 92 mins, Cert PG)

This documentary film tells the inspirational story of Owen Suskind. Owen is a young man who was unable to speak as a child until he and his family discovered a unique way to communicate by immersing themselves in the world of classic Disney animated films.

Thurs, 7 Feb Even the Rain (Spain, 2010, 103 mins, Cert 15)

A film director and his crew are making a film about Christopher Columbus in Cochabamba, Bolivia. Their filming coincides with the Year 2000 Cochabamba protests where the local people rose up against their government's plans to privatise their water supply. The leader in these protests happens to be the main actor in their film!

Thurs, 7 March Hidden Figures (US, 2016, 125 mins, Cert PG)

This film focuses on three real-life African American female pioneers: Katherine Johnson, Dorothy Vaughan and Mary Jackson. These women were part of NASA's team of human "computers" in the early years of the U.S. Space programme.

Thurs, 4 April Of Gods and Men (France, 2010, 120 mins, Cert PG-13)

Nine Trappist monks live among the Muslim population in a quiet corner of Algeria. As the country is plunged into Civil War in the mid 1990's these men must decide whether to stay among the people who have been their neighbours or leave.

Duration:

The films will be shown at Drumalis over seven evenings from 7:30 pm - 10:00 pm on the first Thursday of each month between October 2018 and April 2019.

Cost:

The cost of this programme is £35 sterling per person. This includes refreshments on the seven evenings as well.

It is possible to attend individual evenings at a cost of £6 per evening.
