





DIRECTIONS:

About the Triduum:

The Holy Week ceremonies bring us to the end of our Lenten journey and the beginning of a new journey to freedom in Christ.

As Pope Benedict said:

"And so, today, with great strength and great conviction, on the basis of long personal experience of life, I say to you ...: Do not be afraid of Christ! He takes nothing away, and he gives you everything. When we give ourselves to him, we receive a hundredfold in return."

Our Triduum Retreat begins with supper on Holy Thursday followed by the Mass of the Lord's Supper. Throughout the weekend we will use reflections and liturgies including the Lord's Passion and the Easter Vigil. We will end with breakfast following Easter Sunday morning Mass.





About the Retreat Team:

The retreat is a joint venture combining the inspiration, personnel and resources of Drumalis Retreat Centre and the Belfast Jesuit Centre staff, volunteers and friends.

Duration:

The retreat will commence with registration from 5:00 pm on Holy Thursday followed by evening mealand end with breakfast, which will be served after Mass on Sunday morning.

Cost:

The cost of the Easter Triduum is £310 sterling per person on a residential basis which includes all meals and accommodation.

It is also possible to attend on a non-residential basis - the cost is £190 sterling per person.
